

COMBINE BELTS OR SOMETIMES CALLED PICK UP BELTS

These belts are used on the front of a header or combine **to pick the crop off the ground**, that has been left to dry in a windrow.

The whole pick up front is roughly six or eight foot wide (but can be wider) and therefore there could be as many as five or six belts across the front, or one large one.

The narrow belts are between 17" & 22" wide, with plastic fingers scattered over the belt, held on by special bolts and nuts.

The belts can either be joined by no 2 Clipper joiners other styles of joining the belts are by what they call an overlap join, held by bolts and nuts, or by plates held on by bolts & nuts.

There are a lot of different machines and models, so we need to verify the dimensions exactly before ordering.

Also the number of tynes per belt can vary, depending on the customer.

For some of the older machines, we have to supply a different style of belt than was supplied by the OE machine maker due to the lack of availability of those old style belts and pickup fingers (one such brand is Melroe)
